- We have eliminated round dance lessons and cued round dancing between tips and we will no longer dance at McLarty Recreation Center.

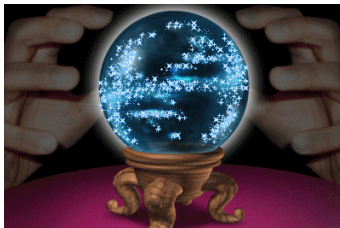
